- High 5 is a modified form of the game specifically designed to develop sound fundamentals – it promotes key skills and principles which enable participants to progress in Netball as they move into secondary school and beyond.
- England Netball has undertaken an extensive mapping exercise to determine which SSPs are in a strong position to further develop school club links (Netball Hotspots) and those in which schools participation is high and has potential to feed school club links (Community focus). In addition they have identified where there are SSPs with an accredited club, in which schools development could be enhanced through school club links work (Schools focus).
