### Merton Mini Sports Leaders Academy

Leaders will initially learn how to deliver a multi skills festival for KS1/KS2 pupils within their school. This course is delivered to around 16 year 5 leaders by the Sports Co-ordinator through a 2hr workshop (with support from a lead teacher/TA). Following the training leaders should be able to take a lead on delivering a KS1 / KS2 multi skills festival with teacher support.

Leaders will then continue within their training and their teacher will deliver the rest of the Academy. Pupils will learn important leadership skills including delivering warm ups, setting up multi skill activities, managing a group of children and encouraging participation.

The Academy should cover 6hrs of training and will be delivered by a lead contact within the primary school. The Sports Co-ordinator will also assess those leaders who chose to go for the GOLD award and cover 12 hours of leadership within the school year. Leaders are able to purchase a red cap to wear whilst taking on the role of Mini Sports Leader in their school.
