- It is anticipated that Key Stage 1 has participated in Infant Agility Skills led by the SSCO before progressing to Sportshall and Quadkid formats.
- Competition priorities have been selected to target year 6/7 transition.
- Super 8 will be piloted in selected County areas in agreement with the SCM and NGB

### Sportshall and Quadkids - Primary

- Option 1 (minimum) – each school to participate in a single cluster heat prior to the winning teams progressing to a SSP Final
- Option 2 – each school participating in a single cluster heat prior to the leading teams progressing to a SSP Final or SSP Plate Final
- Option 3 (preferred) – each school to participate in a series of cluster events (min. 3 including Sportshall Skills Festivals) prior to the winning teams progressing to a SSP Final

### Sportshall and Quadkids - Secondary

- Option 1 (minimum) – each school to participate in a single SSP event / final prior to the winning teams progressing to a County Final
- Option 2 (preferred) – each school to participate in a series / league (min. 4 events) prior to the winning teams progressing to a County Final
